with the legendary American Blues harmonica player Johnny Mars and his band on Friday, May 24th, and a unique evening of top-class Jazz with pianist Craig Milverton and singer Joanna Eden as they celebrate two of America's Jazz greats Oscar Peterson and Ella Fitzgerald with a show called 'An Oscar for Ella'.



I want audiences to enjoy a night of amazing songs from an incredible era of music alongside some great

songs from my own repertoire."

Tony is London born and bred, he thought his future lay in medicine until as a young lad he won a holiday singing competition and decided his vocation was to sing.... The rest is history! Tony

went on to front 80s New Romantic band Spandau Ballet, earning himself the accolade of being one of pop music's greatest vocalists

The band had numerous chart-topping singles

and albums all over the world, including the epic "Through the Barricades" and of course the international number one "True" and the unofficial London Olympics theme "Gold".

The festival is delighted to welcome the Soulful and Funky sounds of MF Robots as they perform a special double bill evening show on Friday 24 May at Blackmore Gardens with Roachford.

Collaborating for the first time while recording and performing with one of the UK's most commercially successful Acid Jazz bands The Brand-New Heavies in 2013, founder and

drummer Jan Kincaid and vocalist Dawn Joseph discovered immediate musical chemistry and began writing songs together right away.

They soon left the band to concentrate on their own work, starting MF Robots (Music for Robots) and releasing an eponymous debut in 2018.

The band have toured the world and were personally asked by Lenny Kravitz to support him on his last European Arena tour – The band's latest record 'Break the Wall' is out on BBE Records and including contributions from studio legends, Gail Anne Dorsey (David Bowie) and Cory Wong (Vulfpeck).


MF Robots - their name, a subtle dig at how generic today's music climate has become - based around Joseph's effusive vocals, mindful of soul's golden age but no revival, and Kincaid's killer

rhythms. Touchstones for Joseph are Anita Baker, Gladys Knight, and Whitney; their classicism viewed here through a modern lens.

Dawn Joseph is a vibrant personality, both on and off stage, with a rich musical past – she started out

> playing bass with Phil Collins' band and has sung with acts as diverse as Kylie Minogue, Michael McDonald and CeeLo Green - she is a part of that lineage that connects Rick

James, Nile Rodgers, and Grace Jones. Her attire, which she designs and makes herself, is flamboyant and colourful and she carries herself with a flair and

> a dark place. To coincide with the album release. Roachford embarked on a run of UK & European dates throughout 2021 and 2022.

From his early days as a junior virtuoso pianist at the Buena Vista Social Club, Roberto Fonseca has been an accomplished and adventurous performer.

Previous releases have seen him blend traditional

styles with a variety of modern influences. 2012's '7 Rayos' offered a cocktail of Cuban sounds, classical music, West-African instruments, electronic music and spoken word poetry.

Regardless of whether you know your mambo, rumba or bolero steps, put your glad rags on – you won't be able to resist swaying your hips to melodies

played by the man who many believe personifies the revival of Cuban music.


He has worked with Baba Sissoko and Fatoumata Diawara in Africa on 2015's 'At Home' album. Most recently, on 2019's 'Yesun' he collaborated with Ibrahim Maalouf and Cuban rap's rising star Danay Suárez.

His latest album, 'La Gran Diversión', is a tribute to Cuban music's golden era, rejoicing in the wild nights of La Havana and Cabane Cubaine, Paris' most famous cabaret of the 1930s. Reverting to tradition might be mistaken for a step backwards by Fonseca but this is an album that bursts with vivacity in its takes on traditional styles. The Mambo, Rumba and Bolero are captured with real verve.
